

PC Network Setup

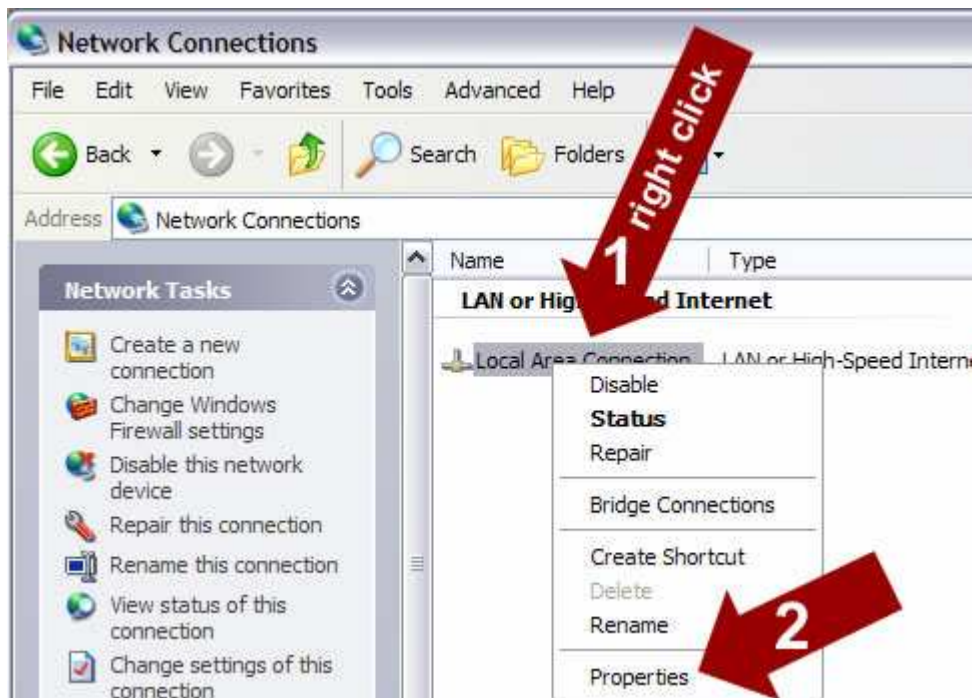
1. Click on "Start" and go to the "Control Panel"
2. Click on "Network and Internet Connections" (view [screenshot](#))



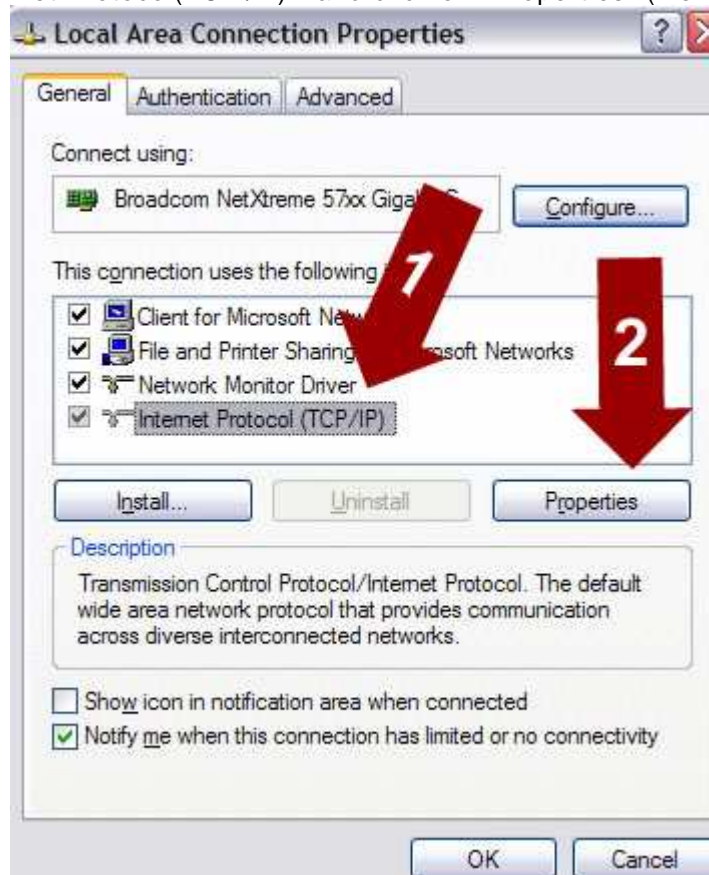
3. Click on "Network Connections" (view [screenshot](#))



4. Right-click on "Local Area Connection" and go to "Properties" (view [screenshot](#))



5. Select "Internet Protocol(TCP/IP) " and click on "Properties" (view [screenshot](#))



6. Make sure "Obtain an IP address automatically" is checked and so is "Obtain DNS server address automatically" is checked. (view [screenshot](#))



7. Next, in internet explorer, click on Tools > Internet Options > Connections > Lan Settings. There are three boxes that can be checked. Only the first one, Automatically detect settings, should be checked. Click ok on both windows, close Internet Explorer, and reopen it. You should now be able to access the internet.
