COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Please replace all requirements in BNT 533 syllabus with the following:

1. **Class attendance.**
2. **Contribution to class discussion.**
3. **Presentation of a biblical passage in class.**
4. **Reading of all textbook material prior to the class for which it is scheduled.**
5. **A 15-20 page exegetical paper of a paragraph in Romans. This can be on the same paragraph as that presented in class (expanded and revised, etc.) In addition to having the formatting required in a regular seminary paper and following Turabian, the paper should be based on the Greek text. The paper should include (1) textual criticism; (2) textual analysis; (3) translation of the paragraph exegeted.**
6. **A notebook containing personal translation of Romans 1-8. It is recommended that this notebook contain three parts: (1) translation section; (2) a personalized section for parsing, vocabulary, grammatical notes; and (3) a general interpretative, etc., observation section.**

NOTE: The student substitutes the translation notebook for the comprehensive exam. But please note: the due date for the notebook is December 7; the due date for the paper is December 14.
